Did you feel prepared for exams?

- Advocate for the availability of more past papers, past paper solutions and correct solutions to students as preparation for the exams (Mech Eng 2)
- Accounting extremely lengthy paper, most of the cohort could not finish
- Economics exam not enough revision material; no past papers/practice exams provided
 - o BMan1 would appreciate being provided with mock exams
- Coursework stacked up towards "end" week before Christmas (Business + Mech Engineering)
- Clashes with deadlines (Business + Mech Engineering)
- Added on requirements mid-way to coursework (Business + Mech Engineering)
- More practice questions available (Business + Mech Engineering)
- Map of Founder's Hall (Unknown)
- More communication (Unknown)
 - Calculators
- Mock exam for 1st years (Unknown)
- Put exam guidance as a unit on Moodle (Unknown 3)
- "Seen exams" make no sense

Did you experience any other difficulties e.g., Wi-Fi problems, having inadequate or no revision spaces, etc.?

- Problems with Modelling Technique 1 (Mech Eng 2):
 - o A lot of students faced issues with the lecturer
 - o Students weren't guided on how to study for the exam
 - o Some topics were not covered adequately
- Wrong question in ME20022 (Question 4) Mech Eng 2
- Not enough space to take online exams (Business + Mech Engineering)
- Some Wi-Fi problems (Business + Mech Engineering)
- Some online exams should have been in-person: less stressful and more appropriate (Business + Mech Engineering)
- Too little time to finish (Business + Mech Engineering)
- If lecturers give extra info about exam, make sure it is consistent with the actual exam (Business + Mech Engineering)
 - E.g., Specified topics were given but question on the exam was about another topic
- Beginning of in-person exam very chaotic (Business + Mech Engineering)
- Inconsistency (Unknown)
- A *incoherent* study space list (Unknown)

- Wi-Fi was very good (Unknown)
- In-person exams could have been done on paper (typing noise can be disturbing) – Unknown 3

Verbal Feedback

- Courses should provide a mock exam experience in a lecture theatre to make students feel more comfortable in an exam atmosphere
- There should be guidance and tips for exam preparation for each module on Moodle i.e., what stationary to bring, what to expect etc
- There should be more consistency between exams on the same course i.e., calculators allowed or not
- There not being clear instructions creates a sense of anxiety which adds to the exam nerves
- There should be a more rigorous review process for exam papers because many people noticed errors in their papers i.e., typos, wrong questions, no calculation listed etc
- The release date for exam results should be communicated more clearly and should be the same across a department
- SAMIS number should be more easily accessible and clear
- Study spaces should be advertised more, through screens in the library or lecturers in class
- Bring back the system where you are not allowed to leave your stuff in a study space for too long
- Taking Online exams on campus is difficult, study spaces are not guaranteed quiet
- There should be more clarity on AI plagiarism i.e., Chatbot
- School of Management require you to print out a data pack and finance it yourself which is unfair
- School of Mechanical Engineering require you to buy drawing boards and only give you a week, there should something different as it is expensive i.e., a borrowing/deposit initiative
- In economics, there is too much reliance on online videos to teach content and it's not a good replacement for in-person teaching
- There should be a calculator initiative as many calculators are lost each year or are not needed by students, set up a different system i.e., where you the university give you money to hand it in and new students can buy them for cheap
- It is unfair when lecturers make a reading compulsory but the university hasn't paid for that content so you cannot access it easily or for free

5 Additional Course Costs

- Drawing equipment in Mech Engineering 2
- Printing Notes (Mech Eng 2)
- "For business context on Semester 2, we are required to provide a minimum of 3 data packs that are printed to the module convenor and the other team and ourselves. These printouts are costly as the data packs are lengthy and many sheets are required to print, and we are personally reimbursing these costs out of our own pocket. (Laptops are not permitted and we cannot digitally share data packs.)" – BMan1
- Coursebooks: most lecturers emphasize you don't necessarily need them, or you can access them online. But you often can't download the whole book or too many people are using the library ones. (Business)
