What is Equality, Diversity & Inclusion Committee (EDIC)?

EDIC is a formal University committee that is responsible for the advancement of equality of opportunity across the University. It reports to the two senior bodies of the University, Council and Senate.

The EDIC Committee, is responsible to Council and Senate for the promotion of ED&I strategy. The EDIC engages with a wide range of equality and diversity issues affecting both staff and students. Its primary role is to raise awareness of equality and diversity issues, set ED&I priorities for the University and to develop, evaluate and review University policies procedures and action plans relating to equality and diversity.

Role Summary

To represent the views of students at the University's Equality and Diversity Committee. The Representative will sit on the Committee alongside University staff and key Students' Union Officers, seeking to positively uphold and implement the aims and objectives of the Students' Union.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Attend and participate at EDIC meetings and briefing/debriefings.
- Read EDIC Committee papers and pass on any queries or comments.
- Work with SU Officers to represent the student voice at the EDIC meetings.
- Interact with senior University staff on EDI issues.
- Engage with other SU process and engagement activities.

Time Commitment:

One academic year minimum. You are required to attend all briefings if you are attending the main meeting.

- 3x EDIC meetings a year
- 1x briefing for each meeting
