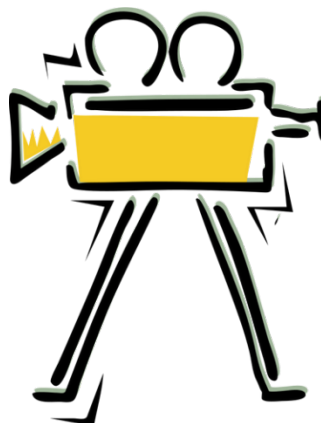


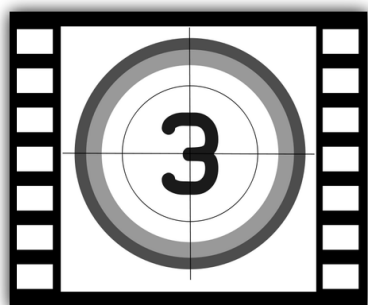
You wish to show a film:

To screen a film to an audience you may use the University's Public Video Screening License (PVSL).

To screen a film using the license it must be listed with the licensing company. you can check what films are covered by the license on <https://www.filmbankmedia.com/> enter a name of a film you wish to check into the search bar top right corner of the page.



To be able to screen a film using our PVS License the following criteria must be met:



- You must source and use either an official DVD or Blu-Ray disc.
- you must not stream online content
- you must not charge for the event.
- It must only be available to students and staff.
- It must be on campus

If your screening event does not meet the above criteria it cannot take place on campus

Please let the Media Usage and Copyright Advisor know which films you wish to screen so a record can kept for the for the licensing company.

If your film is not listed on filmbankmedia.com it will not be covered by the PVSL. It may be possible to obtain a license by other means, though this may incur additional cost. If you wish to charge entry you will need a different license, this can be arranged by contacting the Media Usage and Copyright Advisor:
